

**Greenfield School Committee  
Community Engagement Sub-Committee  
Meeting Minutes  
August 25, 2025**

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1. Roll Call/Call to Order:

2. Public Comment:

5. Discussion of merging all district event calendars into one combined calendar – Identifying if the Greenfield Public School Information Technology Department can merge all district electronic event calendars into one:

- Discussion ensued as to the possibility of having one calendar available that houses all scheduled events/information for all of the schools at all times
- The administration will discuss this option and report back to the sub-committee with their findings
- Also discussed was engaging our social media options and utilizing them to the best of our ability to connect with families and the community – This item will be further discussed at the September sub-committee meeting – The administration will also look into social media options and report back to the sub-committee with their findings
