Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Greenfield School Committee policy on budget planning?

You can find this as policy BDA in the [Fiscal Management section of our policy manual](#) as follows:

The first priority in the development of an annual budget will be the educational welfare of the children in our schools. However, the District will also attempt to balance the valid interest of the taxpayers.

Budget decisions reflect the attitude and philosophy of those charged with the responsibility for educational decision-making. Therefore, a sound budget development process must be established to ensure that the annual operating budget accurately reflects this school district's goals and objectives.

In the budget planning process for the school district, the School Committee will strive to:

1. Engage in thorough advance planning, with staff and community involvement, in order to develop budgets and guide expenditures in a manner that will achieve the greatest educational returns and contributions to the educational program in relation to dollars expended.

2. Establish levels of funding that will provide high quality education for all our students.

3. Use the best available techniques for budget development and management. The Superintendent will have overall responsibility for budget preparation, including the construction of, and adherence to, a budget calendar.

How can I share my views with the school administration and School Committee about the development of the budget?

There are many ways you can offer input as a student, parent or general member of the public. We want to hear the views of staff as well, however staff must be mindful of policy [BHC](#) governing staff communications with the committee, which must go through the Superintendent.
