Sharon Cournoyer - Sharon Cournoyer, of Vernon Rockville, CT, is currently the Superintendent of Schools, Regional School District 19, Storrs, CT. Ms. Cournoyer has been with RSD 19 since 2020. Previously, Ms. Cournoyer served as the Assistant Superintendent of Schools/Interim Superintendent of Schools, Windsor Locks, CT.

Ms. Cournoyer has been in education for 35 years with 20 of those years in leadership. She received her M.S. in Natural Science from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and her Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies (CAGS) in Education Leadership from Cambridge College in Springfield, MA. She also completed a Superintendent Certification Program through Central Connecticut State University.

Carol Kruser - Carol Kruser, of Chicopee, is currently the Assistant Superintendent for Support Services at Chicopee Public Schools. Previously, she was the Vice Principal, then Principal at Chicopee High School.
