I am making a formal complaint to the school committee. After a public meeting I submitted as a public records request (26-208) requesting "I would like any current and future contracts/documents that the school department has for landscaping. In particular, but not only, the contract that was discussed in the budget and finance committee dated on 03/30/2026. In addition, I would like all quotes obtained in relationship with said contract." Request 26-208 was published on the tenth day with the Snow and Son's \$35,892 contract plus some receipts of additional work for Federal St (\$1,800) and Four Corners (\$829) work plus some receipts for mowing some fields in August 2025 (about \$150 each time). However, my request was specific as it did not include the procurement quotes for the \$35,000 project as I asked for. I made a complaint to Clerk Scott that the request did not include the quotes for the project. She made a second request (26-243) to be sent to procurement for the quotes for the project. Very quickly request 26-208 was put back into private mode and I had to request that you ask to make it public again. It appears that the public documents were taken off of the request and then republished and closed. I did not make a copy of the contracts but as you can see, I have very specific information about them. <https://greenfield.nextrequest.com/requests/26-208> Again, as you know, a second request had to be made to get the other quotes (26-243) for this procurement. The request was made public after the 10th day with no documents included and now has become private again. I understand the priority of the city is the town budget and I respect that, but I asked for this information a month ago. I made a complaint that there were no documents attached and this request was again put into private mode. (no link as this has been removed) I have been waiting over a month for this public records request that should have been fulfilled within 10 days. I am concerned that this was purchased and paid for against the states procurement laws. The public records request is definitely past due against public records law. I hereby formally request that the school committee investigate the possibility of a violation of Massachusetts procurement and public records laws by the administration of the school and send me the results of this investigation.
