

Greenfield School Committee
Long-Term Facilities Use Advisory Committee
Meeting Minutes
June 1, 2026

1. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. (This meeting was conducted via Zoom only.)

2. Roll Call of Members (via roll call):

Present: Stacey Sexton, Chair (SS), Elizabeth DeNeeve (ED), M. McKenzie Webb (MW)

SS read the Chair Statement relative to meeting recordings.

3. Public Comment:

Jean Wall, Greenfield resident and Chair of the City Planning and Construction Committee, noted that although she supports an elementary school for the students of Greenfield, she has concerns about having to pay for the tech school. It was always thought that after we paid off the high school we would have extra money to do something for the school system, but it doesn't seem that way while we are paying for the tech school. She suggested meeting with the staff of each of the elementary schools to find out what improvements could be made to the existing buildings to make them better. The City Planning and Construction Committee feels it would be best that we put a new elementary school on a 15 or 20-year plan, being we also need a new police station and a new city hall.

4. Approval of May 18, 2026 draft committee minutes:

On a motion by ED, 2nd by MW, the sub-committee voted to approve the minutes as presented. The roll call vote was unanimous.

5. Update on Advisory Committee recruitment:

The goal is to set an actual recruitment schedule and channel assignments:

- MW offered to reach out to all the PTO groups
- ED offered to handle the social media groups
- It was suggested the School Committee Chair be the voice for a radio spot or an article for the Recorder
- Administrator bundle: Flyers to be sent home from the superintendent's office to include student artwork to gain attention, information included in school newsletters, superintendent blast
- Student interest could be gained through Student Council and other GHS groups, as well as policy JIB: Student Involvement in Decision-Making, once completed
- MW offered to create a draft version of a flyer for input

Timeline review:

- Interest flyers will be sent out ASAP
- Interest form to be sent back by June 22
- This sub-committee will reconvene on June 29 to review interest forms and begin selections
- Nomination selections will be provided to the full GPS School Committee on July 8

6. Adjournment:
