RE: ANNUAL ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION LETTER ~ School Year 2026- 2027

On October 22, 1986, Congress promulgated the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), Public Law 99-519. AHERA mandated that EPA develop regulations to respond to asbestos in schools. On October 30, 1987, EPA promulgated the Asbestos-Containing Materials in Schools rule, 40 CFR Part 763, Subpart E. This rule requires that all of the nation's nonprofit elementary and secondary schools, both public and private, inspect their school buildings for asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM), develop a plan to manage the asbestos for each school building, and notify parents and staff regarding management plan availability.

A copy of our district's Asbestos Management Plan is available in each school and at the District's Office of Facilities and Grounds during regular school hours.
