Welcome to another school year. Please note the following updates from the School Nutrition Department regarding upcoming school year 2021-2022:

- All meals - breakfast and lunch - will be **free for all students** of the Greenfield Public Schools.
- As students return to in-person learning, we will resume meal distribution services much like they were pre-pandemic. We remain committed to flexibility and adjustments as needs change, however.
- High School students can purchase additional menu items and families can view and add to student accounts at MySchoolBucks.com. *Note: there is a \$2.75 fee for all credit/debit card payments.*
- **Discovery School at Four Corners School families, please fill out the School Meal Household Application.** Even though meals are free, this information can qualify eligible children for Pandemic-EBT (P-EBT). **If received after October 1st proof of income will be required. Please submit your Household Application before October 1st!**

As always, our goal is to provide the students of Greenfield Public Schools with nutritious meals and we ask for your patience and understanding as we navigate continued disruptions in supply chains and other transitions and logistical challenges within the school food world.
